

Pre-exposure prophylaxis

WHAT IS PrEP?

Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) is a way of preventing HIV infection by taking antiretroviral medication.

PrEP can prevent the person taking it from acquiring HIV.

PrEP only protects against HIV. Condoms are the best tool to prevent HIV and other sexually transmitted infections.

WHO CAN TAKE PrEP?

PrEP can only be taken by people without HIV who meet certain requirements.

Not everyone can use PrEP, but it is important to know about it.

HOW TO TAKE PrEP?

PrEP is a tablet medication that is taken daily. It requires medical monitoring.

When properly followed, it has extremely high efficacy in preventing HIV, with few side effects.

WHERE TO GET PrEP?

Your local health centre or a local association will be able to guide you through the application procedures.

La PrEP is included in the Spanish National Health System (SNS) and is a free health service throughout Spain.
