## Pre-exposure prophylaxis

## WHAT IS PrEP?

Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) is a way of preventing HIV infection by taking antiretroviral medication.

PrEP can prevent the person taking it from acquiring HIV.

## PrEP only protects against HIV. Condoms are the best tool to prevent HIV and other sexually transmitted infections.

## WHO CAN TAKE PrEP?

PrEP can only be taken by people without HIV who meet certain requirements.

Not everyone can use PrEP, but it is important to know about it.

## HOW TO TAKE PrEP?

PrEP is a tablet medication that is taken daily. It requires medical monitoring.

When properly followed, it has extremely high efficacy in preventing HIV, with few side effects.

## WHERE TO GET PrEP?

Your local health centre or a local association will be able to guide you through the application procedures.

La PrEP is included in the Spanish National Health System (SNS) and is a free health service throughout Spain.
