CEDRE'S SERVICE FOR ASSISTANCE AND GUIDANCE TO VICTIMS OF RACIAL OR ETHNIC DISCRIMINATION INCLUDES:

- Conducting the necessary investigations to determine the circumstances in which the racist incident occurred
- Immediate and free legal advice in the following areas: health, education, housing, employment, labour, criminal, comprehensive care and assistance measures for victims of racist hate crimes, or social services
- Resolution of conflicts
- The drafting, when necessary, of legal documents to natural or legal persons, public or private, with the aim of restoring and redressing, in their entirety, the rights potentially violated in the racist incident
- The indication and advice to the victim of the existing public social resources and, where appropriate, the referral to them
